Trail's Review: This Trail is mostly suitable for Kid friendly, Hiking, Walking, Bird watching, Running, Forest, Views, Wildlife

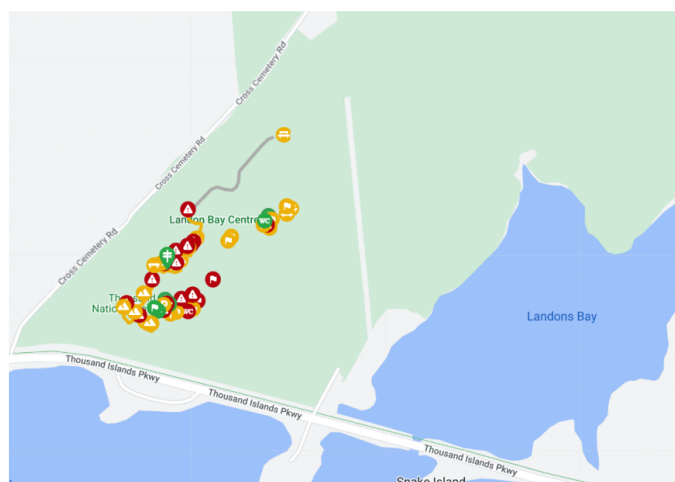


Figure 1: Garden Trail Thousand Island National Park

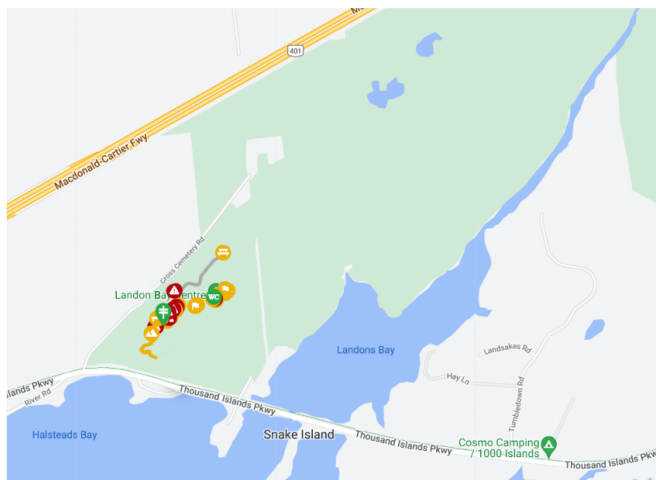


Figure 2: Reviews Locations

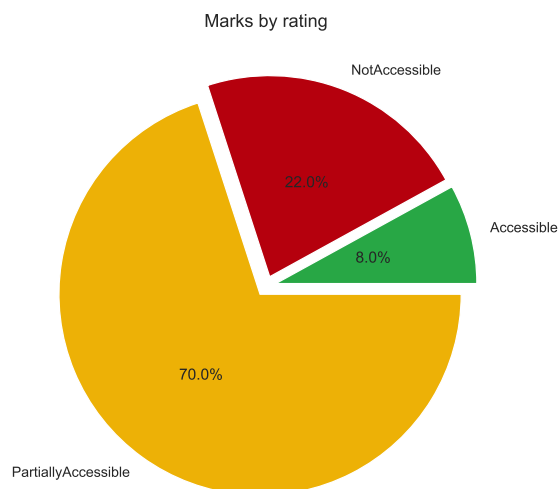


Figure 3: Marks by rating

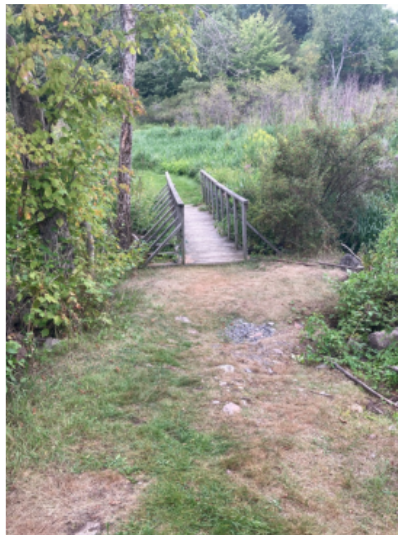


Figure 61: Access to the Donovan Trail is grass with lots of uneven slopes there is a narrow bridge which has a pothole directly in front of it after crossing this bridge you are confronted with a makeshift bridge that is composed of two 2 x 4 side-by-side for quite a while. It cannot be crossed safely.
